



International Programs

Carousel Student Tours provides two types of international programs. The first is an educational tour, the second is a student homestay program. Both programs are fully customizable for your group or you can choose from our menu of trips. We can, if you prefer, organize a trip for as few as six students and as many as 100 students, and we never combine different school groups.



USA Programs

We also specialize in field trips to Washington DC, New York City, and Boston. Over the past 25 years, our company has organized thousands of educational travel tours to these cities as well as other U.S. destinations. Best of all, we work with your school to create an itinerary that suits your needs. We can organize a trip for as few as six students and as many as 500 students.

Homestay Exchange Programs

For schools interested in language immersion programs, we offer a very unique homestay exchange. This is the type of program on which our company was founded. There are two aspects of the exchange: inbound (foreign students visit the U.S.) and outbound (students from the U.S. travel abroad). Schools can choose to participate in the inbound, the outbound or both homestay programs as a combination.



We take care of all the arrangements on both sides of the exchange, including but not limited to:

- Finding homes for incoming students
- Coordinating homes for American students going to Europe
- Arranging all air transportation
- Arranging all excursions and transportation for the students
- Providing a tour escort
